SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST HOLY TRINITY 30th May 2021 (Year B)

Dear Parishioners

This weekend we continue our series of Feast Days with the Most Holy Trinity this weekend and Corpus Christi next weekend. We pray for the children to be Confirmed in a couple of weeks and for those receiving First Holy Communion in July. Sadly, we are not able to have a Blessed Sacrament Procession this year nor the usual picnic in the school grounds, but we hope that the days will be memorable. We have let families know about the restrictions for Confirmation (8 people in total) and for First Holy Communion (12 people in total). Thankfully, we are getting back to some normality and we have been able to celebrate some weddings last weekend and look forward to a number of baptisms and weddings over the next few months. Please think of all the people who have had to postpone the Reception of the Sacraments and now have the chance to celebrate Baptisms, First Confessions, First Holy Communions, Confirmations and Marriages.

The First Confessions for Christ the King will be on Tuesday 15th June at 10.30am and for St Augustine's on Wednesday 16th June at 10.30am. They will be available to watch on the livestream if families want to witness the First Confessions. The Year 6 Confirmations for St Augustine's will be on Saturday 12th June and for Christ the King on Saturday 19th June. First Holy Communions are on the 3rd July for Christ the King and 10th July for St Augustine's. We will be celebrating these Sacraments in a limited way.

The Parish Centre is now open and you can renew or apply for membership. We can increase numbers for baptisms to 30 people, for weddings to 30 people and for funerals 50 people. We will still need to have invited people only to these services and families will have to provide a list of those attending along with phone numbers for track and trace purposes. Please respect these numbers for the next couple of weeks and we hope things will be back to normal by 21st June. For Sunday Masses at Christ the King we will still have the Library available as an overflow and this will continue until the 21st June.

I love You above all things, and I desire to receive You into my soul.
Since I cannot at this moment receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart.
I embrace You as if You were already there and unite myself wholly to You. Never permit me to be separated from You."*

Sacrament of Reconciliation

The Bishops have asked that all should make a Perfect Act of Contrition. Perfect contrition (or a Contrition of Charity) is true and real sorrow for our sins which is created when we realise the immense love of God for each one of us. We express this contrition when we realise how we offend God by our sinful words, deeds and omissions in contrast to the immeasurable love and mercy that He continually shows us.

This requires us to be contrite of heart for what we have done, know and be overwhelmed by the love and mercy of God for His children, and to approach this grace with humility and resolution not to sin again.

An Act of Contrition

My God, I am sorry for my sins with all my heart. In choosing to do wrong and failing to do good, I have sinned against you whom I should love above all things. I firmly intend, with your help, to do penance, to sin no more, and to avoid whatever leads me to sin. Our Saviour Jesus Christ suffered and died for us. In his name, my God, have mercy.
