CHANGES TO THE CELEBRATION OF MASS: As many of you will know some changes have been brought in following the next stage of release of lockdown. Fr. Sebastian has read and looked at the changes and decided that the following will be happening in both Churches:

Holy Water Stoups - will remained unfilled

Votive Candles – People can now light their own candles but under the guidelines that only one person at a time will lit a candle, preferably before Mass, people cannot congregate around them.

Offertory and collection – There will be no changes to the current way this is carried out.

Veneration of Statues – although touching of the statues is allowed we ask that you keep this to a minimum and no kissing.

EUCCHARISTIC MINISTERS: There will be a meeting for Eucharistic Ministers to discuss the changes and for renewal of vows. For SJV the meeting will be on Wednesday morning, after 9.30am and for OLA it will be on Thursday afternoon after 12noon Mass. 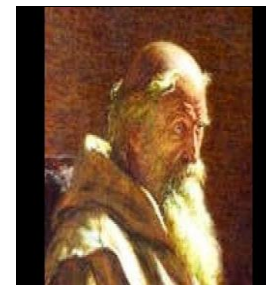
