CHANGES TO THE CELEBRATION OF MASS: As many of you will know some changes have been brought in following the next stage of release of lockdown. Fr. Sebastian has read and looked at the changes and decided that the following will be happening in both Churches:

Holy Water Stoups - will remain unfilled

Votive Candles – People can now light their own candles but under the guidelines that only one person at a time will lit a candle, before Mass, people cannot congregate around them. After Mass it will be the system as before due to the congestion for people exiting Church at OLA.

Offertory and collection – There will be no changes to the current way this is carried out.

Veneration of Statues – although touching of the statues is allowed we ask that you keep this to a minimum and no kissing.

ALTAR SERVERS: There will be a meeting for OLA Altar Servers after Mass on Sunday 13th June.

DIOCESAN VIRTUAL LOURDES PILGRIMAGE: Join from Sunday 30 May for the diocesan annual pilgrimage to Lourdes, which will be virtual for the second year running. The theme of the six-day event is “I Am The Immaculate Conception” and will include daily Masses, virtual Marian Processions, a Service of Healing, Stations of the Cross, a Blessed Sacrament Procession and a Reconciliation Service; together with visits to key locations in and around the holy site in southern France. 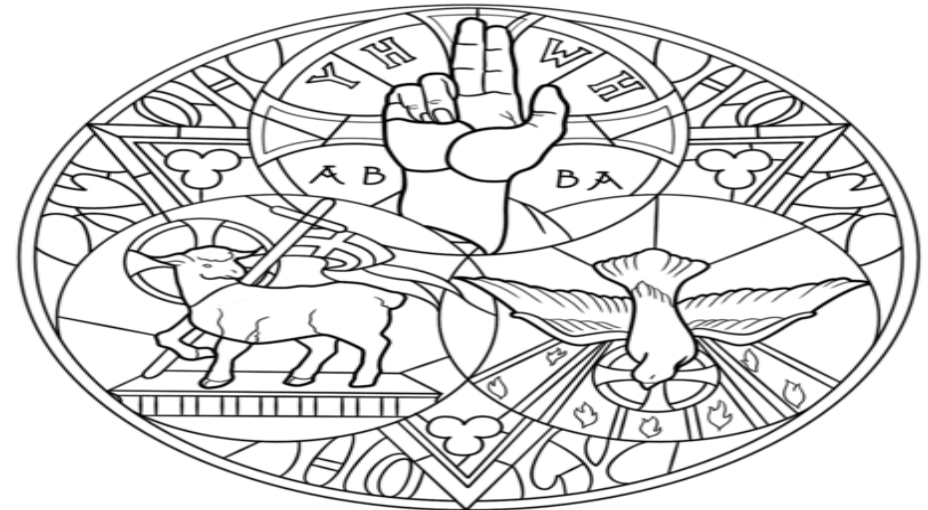
