It is so nice to see the votive candles back again in Church.

We congratulate the children who have now all received the sacrament of Confirmation. In July we will be celebrating First Holy Communion with the children in Year 3

As we celebrate the Trinity God invites us into the wonder of His life as Trinity, and these words by an unknown author invite us to know the union of ourselves with Him:

“Let the past be silent. Let there be no vain regrets, no brooding on past failures, no bitterness, no judgement of oneself or of others. Let all be silent...Let the eyes of the mind be closed that you may hear what otherwise you would not hear, that you may know what otherwise you would not know.

Abandon yourself to Him in longing love, simply, holding on to nothing but Him. So you may enter the silence of eternity and know the union of yourself with Him.”

Open heaven is going ahead! An invitation to all Christians across Coventry to prayer-walk every street. This means getting out physically and praying on

the streets for the people and activities that take place there (you can quietly say the rosary as you walk.)
