THAT THEY MAY BE ONE LIKE US' (Jn17:11)

The strength of any human society depends on unity. Equality, justice, peace and harmony can prevail in societies if each member pursues unity and promotes it. Above everything else, is the unity illumined by the divine wisdom. For example, Jesus said, 'Holy Father, keep those you have given me true to your name, so that they may be one like us' (Jn17:11). Jesus prays for the unity of his disciples, that they may follow the perfect example of the union between him and the Father. The truth of the gospel he taught is that love should grow among his disciples.

Today, we celebrate the 7th Sunday of Easter. The readings draw our attention to a Christian unity which is to be obtained by following the example of the Holy Trinity. We should strive to live in perfect harmony through love. There is nothing that the Father does without the knowledge of the Son, so there is perfect love between them which is manifested in third Person of the Holy Trinity, the Holy Spirit. Jesus said, 'And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Helper, to be with you forever' (Jn14:16). This excerpt fundamentally points to the coming of the Holy Spirit, remembered with the Pentecost Solemnity that we are presently preparing for. We are reminded to allow the Spirit of God to blow into our lives. Our world is torn apart by physical and spiritual illnesses. We need to seek the truth of the gospel to renew us in love, hope, charity, forgiveness, peace and justice. As the world makes scientific, economic and political progress, we need to pay attention to our shrinking spiritual needs. This can only be possible if we long to be consecrated in the truth of the Gospel. To be consecrated in truth is to love one another because God is love. If we hate, ignore, and despise certain group of people, then we show our inability to be true disciples of the Lord. The Gospel that Christ taught is counter cultural, it addresses the evils of human societies like violence, injustice, lack of forgiveness, pride and disunity. May the Spirit of the Lord renew our brokenness to live in the joy of Gospel.
