Parish Newsletter – Most Holy Trinity Sunday 30thMay 2021

THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

The development of relationships confirms the complete realisation of our humanity. The joys or sorrows of life need to be shared with others. In other words, our life is inter-relational or inter-dependable. Above everything else, is our relationship with God, whose revelation is a perfect unity of Three Persons, God the Father of all creation, God who has saved us through the Son, and God who stands by us now and through every crisis by the abiding presence of the Holy Spirit. For example, the Lord Jesus said, 'and I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Helper, to be with you forever' (Jn14:16). The aforementioned excerpt points to the unified action of God's inner nature. As believers, we are expected to follow the example of the Most Holy Trinity in our relationships with each other. The Lord Jesus said, 'You therefore, must be perfect as your heavenly Father is perfect' (Mtt5:48).

Today, we celebrate the Most Holy Trinity Sunday. The Church teaches that, 'The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is the central mystery of Christian faith and life. It is the mystery of God in himself. It is therefore the source of all the other mysteries of faith, the light that enlightens them...'(CCC234). In the gospel the Lord said, 'All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go, therefore make disciples of all nations; baptise them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit...' (Mtt28:19). This command of the Lord underpins the inner operation of the triune God, who creates, saves and sanctifies. He is above our human imagination, transcendent and yet close to us. For example, Moses instructed the Israelites about God's nature when he said, 'the Lord is God indeed, in heaven above as on earth beneath, he and no other...' (Deut4:39). As we celebrate the central mystery of our faith, we are invited to reflect on the love that exists among the Divine Persons, the unity, the respect, reverence and the harmony that they reveal. We also reflect on the generosity of God who, through the Son, has shown us the way to heaven. May we show true love and be generous to God's creation. We should be patient, forgiving and peaceful under the influence of the Holy Spirit in our journey of life.
