## FEAST OF CORPUS CHRISTI (Year B) 6<sup>th</sup> June 2021

Dear Parishioners

This weekend we celebrate the Feast of Corpus Christi. It is a day for us to reflect on the gift of the Eucharist. Unfortunately, this year we cannot have a Corpus Christi Procession, but we can acknowledge the Bread of Life that sustains us on our pilgrim journey. Next week we will have an important Pastoral Letter from the Archbishop about the future of the Diocese and rebuilding after the pandemic. It will also be an invitation to look at new structures and organisation in the Diocese. It will be accompanied by consultation material so that we can feel part of the process. More details next week.

Next weekend we celebrate the first of our Confirmations. The children from St Augustine's school will be Confirmed at Christ the King Church. The larger Church will allow safer distancing for Covid regulations. There will be the 9.30am Mass as usual with the Confirmations at 10.30am for invited guests only. There will not be Confessions or Holy Hour next Saturday morning. Confessions available at 7.00pm after Saturday evening Mass. We welcome Bishop Kenney for Confirmations on 12<sup>th</sup> June and the Archbishop on the 19<sup>th</sup> June. Will all families ensure they have provided the 8 names for their Confirmation via the Eventbrite booking for St Augustine's and direct to the school for Christ the King. The First Confessions for Christ the King will be on Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> June at 10.30am and for St Augustine's on Wednesday 16<sup>th</sup> June at 10.30am. They will be available to watch on the livestream if families want to witness the First Confessions. First Holy Communion are on the 3<sup>rd</sup> July for Christ the King and 10<sup>th</sup> July for St Augustine's. We will be celebrating these Sacraments in a limited way.

The Parish Centre is now open and you can renew or apply for membership. We can increase numbers for baptisms to 30 people, for weddings to 30 people and for funerals 50 people. We will still need to have invited people only to these services and families will have to provide a list of those attending along with phone numbers for track and trace purposes. ## **Make an Act of Spiritual Communion**

This can be done whilst you watch a live stream of Mass being offered by saying the following prayer:

*"My Jesus, I believe that You are present in the Most Holy Sacrament.  
I love You above all things, and I desire to receive You into my soul.  
Since I cannot at this moment receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart.  
I embrace You as if You were already there and unite myself wholly to You. Never permit me to be separated from You."*

## **Sacrament of Reconciliation**

The Bishops have asked that all should make a Perfect Act of Contrition. Perfect contrition (or a Contrition of Charity) is true and real sorrow for our sins which is created when we realise the immense love of God for each one of us. We express this contrition when we realise how we offend God by our sinful words, deeds and omissions in contrast to the immeasurable love and mercy that He continually shows us.

This requires us to be contrite of heart for what we have done, know and be overwhelmed by the love and mercy of God for His children, and to approach this grace with humility and resolution not to sin again.

An Act of Contrition

***My God, I am sorry for my sins with all my heart. In choosing to do wrong and failing to do good, I have sinned against you whom I should love above all things. I firmly intend, with your help, to do penance, to sin no more, and to avoid whatever leads me to sin. Our Saviour Jesus Christ suffered and died for us. In his name, my God, have mercy.***
