“I have sent you, so take nothing with you.”

As always, today's 1st Reading and Gospel go hand in hand. It's a scary world. Especially when we are called to stand up for Christ and for what is right. So we seek confidence. God makes it clear that our confidence should come from him alone. Not from having plenty, or having the latest stuff, or from having status, or being articulate, or talented, or popular. We can use all we have, and our talents etc, to help communicate the Gospel. But what we are called to is to find our confidence in God alone and in the truth that he has called us to be his disciples. It is important therefore that we remain close to him in Mass and prayer and faithfulness - so that we can be confident he is calling us, but once we know that, we find a deep peace. This peace can only come from knowing we are doing his will. We don't have to be successful; we just have to be faithful. So we don't have to worry if we are heard, or noticed - we are simply called to witness, knowing that God's victory is assured, and what he asks me to do is my part in that victory. Truly knowing this frees us from all fear and desire to control.

Greetings! I'm sure you will remember my first weekend with you for a long, long time - if only because it was the weekend England won their first European Championship! (well, let's hope anyway.)

A new priest always takes some getting used to - but so does a new parish too, but let's enjoy getting to know each other. I apologise in advance for doing things differently - what I mean by that is that I've learnt from experience that all priests offer Mass 'differently' - so, although I will consciously do some things differently to Fr David, there will be far more elements that I am just not aware of doing differently to him. So, please don't assume that every change is thought through and deliberate!

It's a good time to be coming to the parish - with, hopefully, our lockdown restrictions coming to an end, we can start looking to the future with confidence, but also with discernment. Lockdown plus reflection can lead us to better see what is important and what isn't, in so many ways. So, rather than simply doing something because that's what we did last week, we now have a chance to revisit the reason for why we do things, and to re-centre on what is most important. And doing that together can be quite energising. Let's see how it goes.

I'm going to fit my induction in sooner rather than later, because it doesn't make sense having it during the summer holidays, and waiting till we get back will be too late really.

Lifting of lockdown restrictions

- Let's try and keep to the remaining restrictions for the next week and a bit - but do remember that I am new to your system, so will get things wrong.
- Even if all restrictions are lifted on 19th, you can still wear a mask and/or keep your distance if you prefer - and we all need to be sensitive to other's preference for space.
- Having said that, we all also need to be aware of the psychological barriers we may have in getting back to normal - and think through ways we can gradually overcome them.
- We also need to get as many back to church as possible, so we also need to think of others whom we can help - practically or psychologically - in returning. Being careful has been, and is, important, but Mass is the most healing event there is.
