## END OF COVID RESTRICTIONS

This means that we will no longer have track and trace as we enter, will not be stewarded to our seats or to communion and the church will not need to be cleaned after every Mass. We will however, for the time being, keep to our one-way system.

While these things will no longer be in place, I would ask that we continue to be very careful in church, respecting each other's space as we know that the pandemic is nowhere near over. Face masks will no longer be compulsory, but I ask that you consider wearing them inside the church if you are able. We do not want to undo the good we have strived for over the last 16 months.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank all those who have volunteered week after week to help during the pandemic – stewarding, cleaning, track and trace, delivering newsletters etc. It is such a blessing to have an army of helpers to keep the church running smoothly and to ensure that everyone is looked after.

Government guidelines allow us to sing again in church, but we will delay this in St Patrick's until September. This will give us time to see how we go with the lifting of all our other restrictions.
