NOTICE FROM THE ARCHBISHOP RE: 19th JULY: Following the announcement that step 4 of the Government's Covid-19 response roadmap will come into effect on Monday 19th July, I am pleased to be able to forward to you the latest guidance from the Bishops' Conference. The guidance is accompanied by the statement *Sunday – it is our Day* which says, "It is our continuing judgement, therefore, that it is not possible at the present time for all of the faithful to attend Mass on a Sunday thus fulfilling their duty to God. It is hoped that it will be possible for all Catholics in England and Wales to fulfil this most important Church precept, that of the Sunday Obligation, by the First Sunday in Advent 2021. In the meantime, all Catholics are asked to do their best to participate in the celebration of the weekly Sunday Mass and to reflect deeply on the centrality of Sunday worship in the life of the Church."

Holy Water Stoups - will remained unfilled, but holy water will be available for you to take home in a small container.

Votive Candles – People can now light their own candles but under the guidelines that only one person at a time will lit a candle, before Mass, people cannot congregate around them. After Mass it will be the system as before due to the congestion for people exiting Church at OLA.

Offertory and collection– There will be no changes to the current way this is carried out.

Veneration of Statues – although touching of the statues is allowed we ask that you keep this to a minimum and no kissing.

Preface of Ordinary Time and Eucharistic Prayer II



St John Mary Vianney (8 May 1786 – 4 August 1859)

Feast Day: 4th August

Born in Dardilly, France, he was the fourth of six children born to Matthieu and Marie Vianney and they were a devout Catholic family. He was ordained a priest in August 1815, he was eventually assigned to a Parish in Ars-Sur-Froman, where he stayed for 42 years. He was devoted to the Sacrament of Penance and spent much of his life in the confessional. Over 6000 people and 300 priests attended his funeral. He was canonized by Pope Pius XI in 1925 and in 1929 he made him Patron Saint of Parish Priests
