THE PRESBYTERY AT OLA: Please note this is a Private Property rented out by the Diocese to the Order to which Fr Emmanuel and Fr Ben belong for their retirement. We therefore ask they are not disturbed by Parishioners ringing or knocking the front door under any circumstance. The Parish Office door is the next door along, which has a post box, if the office is closed and the contact numbers (which are also in here for both Fr. Sebastian and Michelle's mobile) are printed on the office door. If you wish to visit the Presbytery for a private visit we ask that you contact Fr. Emmanuel direct prior to attending.

CHURCH REQUIREMENT FOR COVID:

Face Coverings - The legal requirement to wear a face covering has ended. But government guidance says it "expects and recommends" the continued wearing of masks inside where a crowd is gathered. From September 4th those who do not wish to wear a face covering will be asked to sit in a designated area of the Church (this does not include those who were exempt previously).

Holy Communion – from September 4th Holy Communion will resume being received from the Sanctuary. A steward will invite you up row by row to avoid congestion.

Holy Water Stoups - will remained unfilled, but holy water will be available for you to take home in a small container.

Votive Candles – People can now light their own candles but under the guidelines that only one person at a time will lit a candle, before Mass, people cannot congregate around them. After Mass it will the system as before due to the congestion for people exiting Church at OLA.

Offertory and collection– There will be no changes to the current way this is carried out.

Veneration of Statues – although touching of the statues is allowed we ask that you keep this to a minimum and no kissing.

BLESSED DOMINIC BARBERI (1792-1849)

Feast Day 26th August

Born in Viterbo, Italy. He attended the Passionists and was ordained a priest in 1818. He taught Theology in Rome and served as a Provincial. He had long believed he had been called to an instrument for the conversion of England and in his final years he was given this opportunity of labouring tirelessly in this country, despite facing much opposition. He was also the man who received St John St John Henry Newman into the Church at Littlemore on the 8th October 1845
