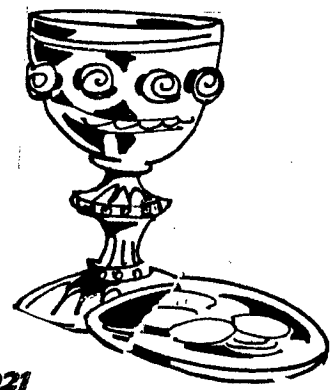
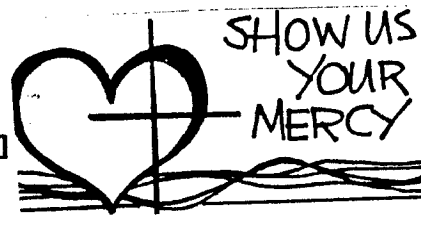

BE HONEST AND FRANK ANYWAY.

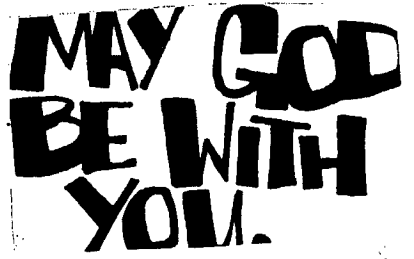
