This weekend we celebrate our parish Feast of Christ the King. It is also World Youth Day. We are asked to pray for all our young people and all of those involved with youth ministry. We are blessed with our parish groups, the Youth Group, the Football and Boxing Clubs, the Guides and Brownies the Toddler Group and our excellent schools. At each of the masses this weekend, some of our young people will talk about youth work and the retiring collection will be for Catholic Youth Services. At the Sunday morning Mass, the children making their First Confession and First Holy Communion this year will be presented with their Rosaries. We pray for them as they begin this important year of preparation. There will also be classes for children at non-catholic schools starting 12th January 2022 at 5.00pm. If you know of anyone who needs to begin preparation for Communion or Confirmation, please contact the office.

Next weekend, sees the beginning of Advent and we will have our Mass next Saturday evening 27th November at 6.00pm for all those who have died in the parish this last year. We will light candles in their memory and people can join us in church or over the livestream. We are hoping to resume our normal rota of Readers and Ministers and the rotas will now appear again on the Newsletter.
