Dear Parishioners

This weekend we are celebrating the first of our Confirmations with the children from Christ the King. The masses have been celebrated at 10.00am and 12 noon. We pray for all those Confirmed, for their sponsors and families. Next Saturday, we will be celebrating with the pupils from St Augustine's school. Again, at 10.00am and 12 noon. Please note, there will be no 9.30am this Saturday at Christ the King but we will have a 9.30am mass next Saturday, the 15th June as usual. We thank the school and parish catechists for preparing the children in our school and those joining from non-Catholic schools.

This Sunday, we will be presenting Carmel Keane with a Papal Bene Merenti Medal. The translation from the Latin means "well merited" and certainly Carmel deserves our thanks for over 20 years of youth work for the parish and the wider Diocese. Her family and friends will be attending. We will fly the Papal flag in honour of the award. We will make a short presentation at the 10.30am Mass at St Augustine's with the main presentation at the 12 noon Mass at Christ the King. Next weekend, we will have the 12.00 noon Mass in celebration of our Deacons and in a special way marking the Silver Jubilee of Deacons Pat and Gerry and the retirement of Deacon Tony Janew. We are grateful for the blessing we have received through the hard work of our Deacons.

On the 23rd June, we will celebrate with the Sisters of the Holy Rosary, marking their 100th Anniversary of their foundation. Also, Sister Ruth will be retiring to Ireland to join Sister Rita and it will be a chance to thank her for her work in the parish.

We have envelopes available as you leave church so that we can make a presentation to the Sisters. We will also have a second collection on the weekend of 22nd and 23rd June to support the work of the Sisters.
