We had a good Parish Finance Committee Meeting. We will be looking at making some improvements to the parish property and ensuring that our buildings are compliant with all the Health and Safety regulations. We will be putting together a Parish Council to look at wider issues in the parish other than finance and buildings. I will be inviting people who work in various areas of parish life such as schools, youth work, liturgical ministries, social outreach, parish clubs and groups, safeguarding and social events, to become members to plan our work as a parish community and to look at ways of growing and developing. These Parish Councils will be established in each of the parishes in the Deanery with an eventual aim of having a Deanery Pastoral Council to encourage parishes to work more closely together and support the ministry of the Clergy. The Family Camp for this year will be from Friday 30<sup>th</sup> August to Sunday 1<sup>st</sup> September. We will start taking bookings over the next couple of weeks.
