'There is one Lord, one faith, one baptism, and one God who is father of all.'

Today starts a series of Gospels taken from John, chapter 6. This is where Jesus teaches us, at length, about his body and blood. It's such an important teaching, which is why it is given such prominence. As always, Jesus starts with what we can see, to help us understand what we can't see. So he feeds the 5,000 with only 5 loaves and 2 fish. This miraculous bodily feeding is preparing his followers for his teaching about the miraculous spiritual feeding to which he is inviting them and us. As Jesus will do, so the Church also gives us an Old Testament reading that will help us understand more. Today, we get Elisha's feeding of 100 people with 20 barley loaves, having some left over. Jesus will talk about how God gave the Israelites, through Moses, the manna in the desert. In both cases, we are being taught that this was miraculous, but Jesus is offering something even more extraordinary. The 12 baskets full of left over speaks to us of the abundance of Jesus' love and offering.
