I will be inviting people who work in various areas of parish life such as schools, youth work, liturgical ministries, social outreach, parish clubs and groups, safeguarding and social events, to become members to plan our work as a parish community and to look at ways of growing and developing. These Parish Councils will be established in each of the parishes in the Deanery with an eventual aim of having a Deanery Pastoral Council to encourage parishes to work more closely together and support the ministry of the Clergy.

We would like to ask our Eucharistic Ministers to take up home visits again. This would only involve a Minister visiting one person at home. Please could all our registered ministers speak with me to arrange to help us in this way to help spread the load for the Clergy. We will have a chance to go through the ritual for house visits so that people are confident in resuming this ministry.

The Family Camp for this year will be from Friday 30th August to Sunday 1st September. We will start taking bookings over the next couple of weeks. We will use the online booking system again this year.
