SCHOOL AND DIOCESAN RELATIONSHIPS

Legally, Catholic schools are classed as 'religious' rather than educational charities. Consequently, to be truly Catholic they must be conducted in accordance with the 1983 Code of Canon law, the teachings of the Catholic Church and the appropriate Diocesan Trust Deed.

They are provided to meet the rights of baptised Catholic parents who wish to have their children educated in accordance with their own religious convictions. They act as part of the evangelistic activity of the Church to be communities of faith and to promote the Gospel by their teaching, their worship and their communal relationships both within the school and with the wider community.

While individual schools each has their own physical characteristics, all the buildings and the land that they are built upon are owned by the diocese. Both are held in trust by diocesan trustees appointed by the bishop.

Under Canon Law the bishop is responsible for all religious activities within his diocese and for controlling diocesan education policy and its schools. He fulfils that responsibility through the foundation governors he appoints to each school, together with the work undertaken by the Diocesan Schools Commission and the Diocesan Department for Religious Education. The bishop is further responsible for all religious activities within his diocese and he has the right under Canon Law to determine what should be taught in religious education lessons, to endorse the appointment of those responsible for religious education and to inspect all aspects of religious education.

The purpose of Catholic schools is to promote Christian faith through education, therefore, they are part of the bishop's mission as supreme pastor of his diocese to ensure that this mission is achieved.

The Catholic faithful of the diocese and parents within a parish where the school is located should take it as their duty to support the Catholic schools within their parish whether they have children there or not. They should look at them as part of their mandate to fulfil the command of Jesus to 'go and make disciples of all nations, to teach and to baptise' (Matt. 28:19).

Wherever they exist, Catholic schools all over the world are overly subscribed. Far from causing anger to Catholics who cannot find entry for their children into them, it should be a cause for joy since it is a testimony to the opinion that people have about Catholic education and of the Catholic Church in particular.
