## The exhibition of the Cross, the Resurrection and the Shroud of Turin comes to St. Patrick's Church 1st – 15th September 2024

An exhibition around one of the most famous religious artefacts in history is coming to St Patrick's. Visitors will be able to see a full-sized replica of the Shroud of Turin as part of a fascinating exhibition which will be on display in our church from 1<sup>st</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup> September. The Shroud is a length of linen cloth that bears a faint image of the front and back of a crucified man. Many believe it is the actual burial shroud used to wrap the body of Jesus of Nazareth after his crucifixion, and upon which his bodily image is miraculously imprinted. The exhibition will also feature other displays and detailed information boards, which cover evidence revealed by historical and scientific research, explaining how the Shroud's image and bloodstains align with Gospel accounts. We are privileged and thrilled to be hosting this incredible exhibition and we hope that it will be visited by many people over the fortnight.

We will be looking for volunteers to be present in the church for a couple of hours a day while the exhibition is in progress and a sign up list will be put out in the next couple of weeks.
