Dear Parishioners

We need to have final numbers for the Family Camp. At present 50 people have booked in and we need about 100 to make it worthwhile. I know people tend to leave it to the last minute, but that is not helpful to us in our planning. If you are a regular and have not yet booked in, please don't leave it to chance. You could also be in contact with other families who you might think will be interested so that we can confirm bookings. We will let you know by next weekend if the camp will go ahead. Just to remind you, the camp is from Friday 30th August to Sunday 1st September. There is a booking form available at the back of the church as well as the option of using the link in the newsletter, or by phoning the office. Please use one of these signing up options as soon as possible and let other families know of the need to sign up. You will be given payment details in due course and the cost is £15 per person for the weekend and £7.50 for a day guest. It's excellent value as it's £60 for a family of four. Over the weekend of 14 / 15th September, the Bishops of England and Wales will be encouraging us to pray before the Blessed Sacrament. There is an "Adoremus" event at Oscott College.
