Scam Alert from Archdiocese of Birmingham

Please be on the lookout for a new scam and share with parishioners, especially those who may have travelled with a religious event organiser. We believe that parishioners who have travelled with an independent travel company, on tours to religious sites are being targeted. Fraudsters pretending to be from the travel company are writing to parishioners who have travelled on a religious tour asking for donations. They are saying they have fallen on hard times and provide their bank account details so people can donate.

Please do not donate – this is a scam.

If you have donated, please report it to the police at Action Fraud on telephone number 0300 123 2040 or online at actionfraud.police.uk and report it to your bank. (Dial 159 to be automatically connected to your bank's fraud prevention service). If you receive any correspondence or emails from any travel company, asking for money, don't make any payments and report it to the police at Action Fraud. If you live in England or Wales and have been a victim of fraud or cybercrime, report it at www.actionfraud.police.uk or by calling 0300 123 2040. In Scotland, victims of fraud and cybercrime should report to Police Scotland on 101. Please share this with anyone who may be affected.
