## Preparing for the Lectionary - refresher programme for ministers of the Word

A new edition of the Lectionary using the English Standard Version Catholic Edition and the Abbey Psalms and Canticles will come into use in England and Wales on the First Sunday of Advent, 1<sup>st</sup> December 2024. A free refresher programme for ministers is being offered online in two sessions from 15-16.00 on Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> October 2024.

The first session focuses on ministry and the Word and the second focuses on the Lectionary itself and strategies to promote Scripture in parish life.
