The exhibition of the Cross,
 the Resurrection and the Shroud of Turin comes to St. Patrick's
 Church 1st – 15th September 2024

An exhibition around one of the most famous religious artefacts in history is coming to St Patrick's. Visitors will be able to see a full-sized replica of the Shroud of Turin as part of a fascinating exhibition which will be on display in church from our 15th September. The Shroud is length of linen cloth that bears a faint image of the front and back of a crucified man. Many believe it is the actual burial shroud used to wrap the body of Jesus of Nazareth after his crucifixion, and upon which his bodily image is miraculously imprinted. The exhibition will also feature other displays and detailed information boards, which cover evidence revealed by historical and scientific research, explaining how the Shroud's image and bloodstains align with Gospel accounts. We are privileged and thrilled to be hosting this incredible exhibition and we hope that it will be visited by many people over the fortnight.

We would like to make this exhibition available to as many people as possible and that depends on volunteers to be present in the church for a couple of hours a day while the exhibition is in progress. There is a sign up list for volunteers on the table by the side door. Please look at your diaries and see if you can help. The more volunteers we have the easier the task for all of us.
