St Augustine, whose feast day was last Wednesday, was famous for saying, 'You have made us for yourself, Lord, and our heart is restless, until it finds rest in you.' It is such a powerful line, and helps us understand something very important about what it is to be human. Deep within us we have this longing for God. We all experience the restlessness that stems from living in this unfulfilled state. We all see the damage around us when that restlessness remains unfulfilled and misunderstood. So may destructive impulses rise up in us from this longing, but the longing itself is the best part of us. Also planted inside us is the word of God, which helps us understand our longing, and how to have it gradually fulfilled. Submitting to this, we gradually grow and the longing becomes a source of tremendous good. The Mass, trust in God, prayer, learning about our faith, discussing it with other - all these help us separate the destructive impulses in us from our deeper, good ones - bringing peace, growth and joy.

AN EXHIBITION OF THE TURIN SHROUD AT ST PATRICK'S: 1ST-15TH SEPTEMBER, 2024

An exhibition around one of the most famous religious artefacts in history is coming to St Patrick's, Deedmore Road, Coventry CV2 2HW. Visitors will be able to see a full-sized replica of the Shroud of Turin as part of a fascinating exhibition which will be on display in our church from 1st to 15th September. The Shroud is a length of linen cloth that bears a faint image of the front and back of a crucified man. Many believe it is the actual burial shroud used to wrap the body of Jesus of Nazareth after his crucifixion, and upon which his bodily image is miraculously imprinted. The exhibition will also feature other displays and detailed information boards, which cover evidence revealed by historical and scientific research, explaining how the Shroud's image and bloodstains align with Gospel accounts. The exhibition will be open Tuesdays to Fridays 5 - 7pm, Saturdays 12-4pm, Sundays 11.30am-1pm. All welcome.
