This Sunday there is a Talk on the New Lectionary to be held at St Mary and St Benedict's on Sunday  $29^{\text{th}}$  September at 3.00pm, given by Fr Allen Morris. This would be a good talk to attend, especially for our readers. All welcome.

Next Sunday, we begin our blessings at the cemeteries, beginning with Canley on  $6^{\rm th}$  October, St Paul's,  $13^{\rm th}$  October, London Road,  $20^{\rm th}$  October and Lenton's Lane, Sunday  $27^{\rm th}$  October. All at  $3.00 \, \rm pm$ .

Fr Benedict has produced a short training video for our Ministers, especially for those who were not able to attend The Eucharistic Devotion.
