Today we are celebrating our Harvest Masses. It is important we give thanks to God - and to all the people involved - for the food we eat daily. We need food and drink so regularly, and yet I for one have only once gone hungry through circumstance. It is so easy, in a country of plenty, and of supermarkets and endlessly open shops, to forget, and to take food for granted. So, today, we bring our 'tithe' of food to God, thanking him for feeding us. We do also need to pray for our farmers after a very, very bad harvest this year, due to weather etc.

Jesus tries to teach us to trust completely in the Father. We can only enter heaven when we do. The rich young man is not able to do that today. He wants to trust in God and his own financial security. It's so tempting! St Francis, and many others, were able to give all they had away - to completely trust in God's providence every day. And none of them went without. Trusting God completely really does work - and sets us free. But letting go of earthly securities, and of self-trust, needs God's grace. We can start by at least appreciating the food he gives us.

JOURNEY IN FAITH We start our journey in Faith course on Thursday 14th November, 7.45 - 9.00pm in the Tuite Room at Corpus Christi. We run this jointly with Sacred Heart and Fr Tony. It is primarily for adults wanting to become Catholic - or at least interested in that. But it also works as a great refresher for Catholics, who often stop learning about their faith once they leave school - which was quite a while ago for many of us! We've been thinking about being home missioners for a few weeks now - well this is one of the easiest ways of being one. Think of someone you could invite to it - and even come along with them. I've honestly never known anyone come on the course and not get lots out of it, Schedule and invites to follow, next week.

EUCHARISTIC MINISTERS Could any new ministers join me please 9.30am - 1pm on Sat 23rd November at St Anne's, to receive spiritual and practical training? Then, Covid permitting, we will start offering the Precious Blood at Christmas time.

COVENTRY EAST MISSION There was a good turn out from Corpus Christi at our meeting with Bishop Richard on Thursday. Thank you. The bishop spoke well, and was complemented by Canon Peter Smith who explained how canon law helps us to get our structures right, and be life-giving. The first thing every parish is asked to do is form a Parish Council - well, actually, Canon Peter was telling us it should be called a Pastoral Council. We already have one, though maybe we do need to just change the first word of the name! So, we are ahead of some parishes in this. After that, the Archbishop has asked us to have a Deanery Council, to help steer the deanery and the four Missions of Coventry. These are opportunities for priests, deacons and lay people to work together in discerning the way ahead.

DEANERY QUIZ, CHRIST THE KING SOCIAL CLUB Friday 18th October, starting at 8pm - arrive rearly to get table and settle in. Snacks put on, and bar available. Teams of up to 5, £10 per team.
