Dear Parishioners,

It was a fantastic response, overall, from our three Masses and two schools, in bringing in food for the harvest. Thanking God for the food, by bringing him our 'tithe', is vital, and offering that food to those in need via the foodbank is truly Christ-like. If you want to please any parent, help out your brothers and sisters - and that's exactly what we did. The Foodbank were very grateful.

**Volunteer Forms** Again, a great response from you - over 100 returned. We've now collated them and the Parish Council met Thursday to try and organise things. So, in the next few weeks anyone who has volunteered should be getting a call from me or a helper to chat with you about your offer and how we might proceed. I think this is a big turning point in our parish journey. Thank you. Of course, it's not too late to fill one in and put it in the box.

**KARIS CENTRE** I think we are entering another important stage in our renovation. Workers are beginning to do their stuff. Lots of you have volunteered to help, once it is open - and the management committee will be in touch with you to gradually get us ready that way. We have met with the Council and, this week will meet the Primary Care Trust, about them helping with our Linkline. We have also built up a good relationship with Adult Education Services, who are keen to really work with us at the Karis Centre. So, as well as your continued prayers, and your offers to volunteer we need two big things:

This time last year we did a 'public consultation' about wanting and using the centre. We got 469 replies and this really strengthened our bids. This time we need to do another **public consultation - about what courses adults might want to study in our centre**. Can we please all join in with this? 1) please fill one in yourself, if any course appeals to you; 2) please ask local friends, family and neighbours to fill one in; 3) could some of you canvas a street or two, like you did last time? 4) could some help with the footballers' parents in the evening? We've given you 2 forms today - maybe one for you one for someone you know? - and there is the online version <https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/Karis24> Next week, we'll have cards with that online address on, so you can simply hand a card to someone, or push it through their door. Many hands make light work - so please join in.

Please do join in with our **Karis Centre clear out** this coming Saturday, 26th, 12 noon onwards - in fact David will be starting at 11am, so you can join him then, if you like. We need people who can shift stuff - but also you could help by providing cuppas for the workers! There's a lot to shift, so please help.
