Deanery message from Monsignor Tom Farrell

Thanks to all who attended the Open Meetings for the Deanery with Bishop Richard Walker. Hopefully, it will help us to begin thinking about the importance of Pastoral Councils for the parish and for the Deanery and to look at ways of working closely with our neighbouring parishes and to support the work of our schools in promoting our faith.

It would be good to read the Future Planning Leaflet that we distributed a couple of weeks ago if you have not already done so. The next steps will be looking at the formation of Parish Pastoral Councils by the new year and trying to follow the timetable outlined in the leaflet. On 21st November there will be the first meeting of Headteachers from both the Coventry and Nuneaton schools to reflect the new Deanery arrangements.
