"WHAT GOD HAS UNITED MAN MUST NOT DIVIDE"

Christian marriage is one of the core values of faith in the Lord as it is one of the seven Sacraments. It fulfils God's eternal plan for His creation. It is in marriage that the human potential for life is comprehensively fulfilled. The expected helpmate in life is found in marriage. In the book of Genesis, man and woman were created for each other as helpmates. When Adam found his right companion he exclaimed, 'This at last is bone from my bones and flesh from my flesh' (Gen2:23). It was an affirmation of complete mutual relationship. The Church teaches that, 'The intimate community of life and love which constitutes the married state has been established by the Creator and endowed by him with its own proper laws.... God himself is the author of marriage' (CCC 1603). The purpose and meaning of Christian marriage is from God. Therefore, when baptised Man and Woman exchange their consent in the Marriage covenant, the two become one body and nobody can divide. 'What God has united man must not divide' (Mk10:9).

Today, we celebrate the 27th Sunday. The theme of the readings invites to reflect on the mystery of the Sacrament of marriage as the eternal plan of God for humanity. It is in marriage that the continuity of the human race is realised. It is also within family settings that the younger generation are introduced to the values of society and the importance of faith. We share life experiences and we support each other in family connections. As mentioned, in the first reading from the book of Genesis, "The Lord God said, 'It is not good that the man should be alone. I will make him a helpmate' (Gen2:18). In marriage, therefore, the values of care, sharing, understanding and affinity are nurtured for the wellbeing of all the parties. Christian family members should promote each other for holiness. The ultimate goal of our lives is to attain eternal life, and this can be achieved through healthy marriage life. It was on this ground that Jesus said, 'The man who divorces his wife and marries another is guilty of adultery against her.' Christian marriage is a permanent relationship, and it calls for faithfulness. It is ordained by God. The Lord Jesus said, 'But from the beginning of creation God made them male and female. This is why a man must leave father and mother, and two become one body' (Mk10:6-8). Divorce, therefore, contradicts this Divine institution. As Christians, we should be aware of the dangers that can affect our family life; scepticism, cultural liberalism, relativism, materialism and busy life attitudes. May the Lord touch our hearts and minds to follow His instructions on the mystery of Christian marriage.
