Today we hear about the end of the world, the signs of distress that will precede it, and the judgement that it will lead to. We hear of the Book containing all the names of those who will be spared. Today we also have a pastoral letter from Archbishop Bernard speaking about another book - the new Lectionary, which will come into use on 1st December, the First Sunday of Advent. This has the readings we use for Mass, obviously taken from **the** book - the Bible. There is a connection between these books - reading the book of life, which is what the Bible is, and allowing the word to form us, is a sure way of having our names in the book of the living. Change isn't always easy, but the new translation gives us a chance to hear the Word of God anew. It also unites all the English speaking parts of the word, which is a good and Catholic thing to do.

Let's welcome the New Lectionary. Do have a think about ordering a weekday and/or Sunday Missal, £13 each, for you to read the readings before Mass, as ideal preparation for coming to church.

Thank you to all who helped make Tuesday's deanery Mass for deceased clergy so powerful and moving.

Money up front would help; or bring it next week. They're £13 each, or obviously £26 for the set of two.

Readers, please do come to our meeting Saturday 30th November, 10.30am at St Anne's - obviously it would be even better if you could come to 9.30am Mass first.

The 8 new lectionaries have arrived (4 volumes for each parish), and will have the inserts in by next weekend, *in memoria* of those whom you have asked for. Since so many people did show an interest in this idea, I wonder, should we get a Book of The Gospels to use at Sunday Mass? They do cost £275 (or more if we want the deluxe version). Would anyone be interested in having one dedicated? Maybe even a shared dedication? Let me know.

Volunteers Could anyone willing to help with counting the collections at St Anne's meet after Mass today (Sunday) - with Christine stepping back a bit, we do urgently need to find a way forward. We also have the following mini-meetings coming up: after 11am Mass CC anyone willing to help with Children's Liturgy; after 7pm Mass Tuesday, CC, any new adult servers; Sat 30th November 11.45am ish, anyone interested in starting Children's Liturgy at SA. Thanks.

Thank you also for the many positive responses to what I said last week at St Anne's. The collection was up as well! It is in our hands to thrive - we had over 130 at Mass last week - but it does need us all to take responsibility, and for our good intentions to be backed up by commitment. Let's all play our part.

KARIS CENTRE We did very well with our adult education forms - over 230 were completed hard copy or online. Thank you! Maybe more from school parents and footballer parents, than parishioners, but that's ok. It's meant to be a Community Centre. Adult Education Services were very impressed, which bodes well.

Sadly, as you know we have had problems with getting started with building work. We have had to part company with the project manager. This will mean, sadly, that, having a main contractor will cost more than we hoped, but at least we will be on a surer, more accountable footing. We've met with the diocese about our plan b - and received an initial positive response. The Parish Council and Finance Committee are meeting this Thursday - I hope to have more to share with you after that.
