Dear Parishioners

This week we begin our Commemoration of the Holy Souls and we will be reading out the names from the Book of Remembrance at each of the masses through November. Please let us have your Holy Souls envelopes with the names of the deceased so these can be included in the Remembrance Book. The book will be on the Sanctuary for the month. The donations will be given to the St Vincent de Paul Society, supporting local people in need. Unfortunately, the Holy Souls box was stolen from the church last Sunday afternoon, so it's not sensible to leave out another one, so we would ask that you place the November envelopes in with your collection as you come up to communion or post it through the Presbytery letter box. We have the culprit on CCTV so this may not be the end of the story!!

Thanks to all who attended and helped with the cemetery blessings over the last month. I know that people appreciated this. The Annual Mass for those who have died this last year will be on Saturday 16th November at 6.00pm. We have written to all the bereaved families from the last year to invite them to the Mass.
