LOVE GOD AND YOUR NEIGHBOUR!

The fundamental truth of a right religion underpins the basic human value of the love of God and our fellow human beings. This basic value of love goes beyond the boundaries of geography, race or any of our human affiliations. It is from within this context that the Lord Jesus instructed his disciples, "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptising them in the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you" (Matt28:19-20). This mandate given by the Lord implies that in accepting Him when making the profession of faith during the sacramental rites, we are expected to show true love by obeying His commandments as the Church instructs us today. We can, therefore, pose many questions. Do we truly reflect our love for God by following his commandments? Do we express our true love for him in prayers of thanksqiving, contrition and petition? What is our concern for the needy and suffering in our society? These questions evoke a deep spiritual concern as we reflect on the love of God and neighbour as the basic truth of faith practice. In most cases, we are tempted to be concerned about ourselves, our needs, or our family requirements even when we have more than we need at a particular moment. We need to have the joy of Christian faith through sharing our life and our resources.

As we celebrate the 31st Sunday, the theme of the readings invites to reflect on the love of God and neighbour. We are reminded to focus on the will of God by following his commandments. Following the will of God gives us blessings and a joy of life. As Moses instructed the Israelites, "If you fear the Lord your God all the days of your life and if you keep all his laws and commandments which I lay on you, you will have a long life" (Deut6:2-3). The same instruction is echoed in the reply Jesus gave to the Scribe who asked which was the greatest commandment. Jesus replied, "This is the first: Listen, Israel the Lord our God is the one Lord, and you must love the Lord your God with all your heart..." (Mk12:28-30). Loving the Lord with all your heart means your entire life, plans, attitudes and deeds should be directed towards glorifying God. As Christians today, we can be still, reflect and

glorifying God. As Christians today, we can be still, reflect and look around asking ourselves if our actions reflect God's life and will. It may be that we simply listen to ourselves and follow our own will more than following the holy will of God. May we therefore, renounce all actions that prevent us from expressing our true love for God and neighbour. We may then have the joys of life as promised by our Lord, both now and for ever.
