

THE GOAL OF CHRISTIAN LIFE!

As we come towards the end of the Liturgical year, the words of Saint Paul resonate in our minds and hearts, 'I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith' (2Tim: 4: 7). We are invited to look back on the past year and consider whether or not we have developed spiritually. Our fundamental goal of life is to seek holiness in all that we do within our families, workplaces and parish communities. What are the contributions that we have made where we can truly say that we have done the will of God during the past year? Our faith in the Lord directs us to eternal life but only through the path of holiness as manifested in love, justice, honesty, faithfulness and charity. Have we practiced these virtues throughout the year? At the end of our earthly life, we are expected to face Death, Judgment, Heaven or Hell. As believers, we are expected to run the race to a good finish by living holier lives. Each passing cycle of the year reminds of these realities. The beauty and the hope for us is that Lord is always with us.

As we celebrate the 33rd Sunday, the readings remind us of the abiding presence of the Lord and how we should place all our hope in him. Many strange things continue to happen in the world such as the occurrence of uncalled for wars, violence, natural calamities, diseases and the death of beloved ones. We are called to not lose heart and faith in the Lord. We are reassured by the Gospel when Jesus says, 'In those days, after the time of distress, the sun will be darkened, the moon will lose its brightness, the stars will come falling from heaven and the powers in heaven will be shaken...' (Mk13:12). This was to prepare the minds of the disciples for the second coming of Christ. All of us hope for that day of the second coming of Christ, whether individually at the time of our death, or collectively at the end of time. What is important is that we shall be with him for ever, eternally, provided we live lives that are worthy of him whilst we are on earth. Secondly, we have been given an assurance of life hereafter with Him. Jesus said, 'And this is the will of him who sent me, that I should lose nothing of all that he has given me but raise it up on the last day' (Jn6: 39). The second reading underpins this great hope by saying; 'By virtue of that one single offering, he has achieved the eternal perfection of all whom he is now sanctifying' (Heb10: 14). We can be sanctified if we obey the Lord and follow his commandments, by loving God and our neighbours.
