'Every valley shall be filled, and every mountain and hill shall be made low.'

St John the Baptist enters our Advent story today. He changes the Advent prophecies of hope from 'this will happen' to 'this is beginning to happen'. The start of the Gospel - with all its names and details - reminds us that Jesus comes to us in time - including here and now. It is too easy to hope that God will do something, sometime, somewhere, it takes courage to believe he comes with his healing power here, now, to us.

But that is what we are asked to believe as we come for the Laying on of Hands, and for Holy Communion. Our faith comes before healing - or else it is not faith. And our 1st reading reminds us that Christ's healing is for his people, not for an individual. We can do lots of holy things, but stay safe in an isolated relationship with God - me and him. He calls us to come to him together, and to pray for and help each other. So, let us do just that, and pray for each other as we receive his healing and peace.
