PREPARE A WAY FOR THE LORD

The quest for a good life has always been the concern of people of every generation. We are longing for a happy life and a bright future of contentment and peace. Our experience reveals the many natural and human challenges to a good life: epidemics, destructive hurricanes, floods, volcanic eruptions, destructive acts of violence, acts of genocide and the threat of nuclear wars which interfere with people's wellbeing and growth.

Without falling into an error of oversimplification of complex issues, as Christians we affirm that we have an answer to all human longings for peace. Humanity needs God, and we must take a personal responsibility to welcome God in our lives. The Word of God which is ever old and yet ever new provides answers to all our questions.

On this Second Sunday of Advent, the message of John the Baptist is most appropriate to address our quest for reconciliation and peace in the world, and in our families. When we integrate acts of repentance and forgiveness in our lifestyles, we set the stage for harmony in the world.

When the prophets invited their people to prepare a way for the Lord, they were giving them a key of hope for a bright future. The message of prophet Baruch to the people of Jerusalem is relevant to us too when he said: 'Take off the garment of your sorrow and affliction, O Jerusalem, and put on for ever the beauty of the glory from God. Put on the robe of the righteousness from God' (Baruch 5:1). In fact, the ideal identity of humanity will be defined by the new name Peace of Righteousness and Glory of Godliness (5:4).

The season of Advent invites us to prepare for the Lord by repentance from acts of pride, greed, and selfishness, which exclude God in a human heart, lead to disaster and gloom for the many that are downtrodden, and they dehumanise the oppressor! Repentance and a genuine turning to God will reverse the story of humanity and lead to genuine progress. Thanks be to God, Christ who comes to make us ambassadors of his saving actions and true Pilgrims of Hope to the people of our generation. This makes the message of John the Baptist a highly relevant one for us today.
