YEAR OF JUBILEE

Pope Francis has announced that 2025 will be a year of Jubilee, a holy year which happens every 25 years in the Catholic Church. The Pope



describes this year as, 'an opportunity to be renewed in hope' because it is a time for forgiveness and reconciliation, in which people are invited to come back into right relationship with God, with one another, and with all of creation.

The theme of the Jubilee Year (which begins this Christmas eve with the opening of the holy door at St Peter's Basilica in the Vatican and ends on the Feast of the Epiphany 2026) is 'Pilgrims of Hope' and every Catholic is invited to rediscover a spirituality of God's creation in which we understand ourselves as "pilgrims on the earth" rather than masters of the world.

You can discover more about the coming Jubilee Year by reading and reflecting upon the 'Pilgrims of Hope' Guidebook which will be available at this weekend's masses. You might also like to attend a session about the meaning and significance of the Jubilee Year. This session will take place in our parish meeting room immediately after mass (11.30am to 12.30pm) on Sunday 12th January 2025.
