# INAUGURATING THE JUBILEE YEAR IN OUR LADY OF THE ANGELS PARISH

Today we inaugurate the Jubilee year in our parish of Our Lady of the Angels. A jubilee is important because it celebrates a significant event in our life, namely that In Jesus Christ we have become Pilgrims of hope walking towards the Father. A Jubilee is a time for us as a Catholic Community in our town of Nuneaton to reflect on our role as evangelisers. We have a mission to do here otherwise it is useless to be baptised or to claim the title Christian. In the Catholic Church, a Jubilee or Holy Year is a special year of forgiveness and reconciliation, in which people are invited to come back into right relationship with God, with one another, and with all of creation. Sometimes we live a broken life, experiencing disharmony within us and among us. The Jubilee year is the time to make amends, to look on the brighter side, to walk an extra mile, to cast our nets in the deeper waters. Pope Francis has invited all of us Christians, to renew our hope and to rediscover a vision that can "restore access to the fruits of the earth to everyone". We are invited to rediscover a spirituality of God's creation in which we understand ourselves as "pilgrims on the earth" rather than masters of the world.

Our parish is rooted in hope, different groups of parishioners engage in all sorts of ministries as a means of contributing to the building up of the Kingdom of God on earth. We shall start 9.15 am and 11:00am Masses from the parish hall and make pilgrimage of hope through the main door of the Church. That door represents Christ himself who teaches us that he is the door, through whom we pass to reach to the Father. As we shall walk through the door of our parish church, we shall invoke the Holy Spirit to renew our hope, that keeping our eyes fixed on Christ, we may never be drowned in the abyss of despair.

This weekend we start our Jubilee celebrations led by children, the choice for this is based on the role they play in our families to spread the gospel. In their simplicity, children speak to their parents about God, or raise questions about faith in God or challenge their parents about not doing things that children consider important such as: Mom can we go to church, why don't you receive Holy Communion, when will I receive Holy Communion etc? Sometimes family members pay a deaf ear to these questions, or might dismiss the questions raised by a child, but we have to realise that by these questions, children keep the light of faith in the family more than you would imagine.

Every group will have the opportunity to lead us in the celebration of the Jubilee in its own way. This is a moment of grace. Where each group can help to communicate the gospel through worship. I ask leaders and coordinators to mobilise action as a mark of their celebration of the Jubilee 2025. The next Jubilee in the Church will be in 2050!
