*Just a reminder that the closing date for applications for school, for children born between 1/9/2020 & 31/08/2021, is **Wednesday 15 January 2025**. Applications received after this date will be considered with other late applications in May 2025 which could affect your application. Applications should be made online via Coventry Primary admissions – **Primary school admissions – Coventry City Council** or by telephone **024 76975445**. The outcome of school allocations will be notified to parents by email, on **16 April 2025**. Parents must also ensure **the school** has received a copy of the child's baptism certificate, if the child is a baptised Catholic child, by **Wednesday 15 January 2025**.*

A copy of the school's Admission Policy 2025/2026 is available on the school website. Please note attendance at Nursery, does not give you any higher priority for admission to the school reception classes, a separate admission criterion applies.
