OTHER PARISH NEWS

<u>TODAY</u> there will be a Second Collection for Cathedral Maintenance. St Chad was born in the 7th Century. He was educated at Lindisfarne. As a bishop he established his See at Lichfield. His reputation spread quickly and favourably as a kind pastor who sought out the lost and cared for the sick. He died at Lichfield in 672. Today his shrine is located in St Chad's Cathedral, Birmingham. He is the patron saint of the Archdiocese of Birmingham.

THE SEASON OF LENT helps us to prepare for the celebration of Easter. The forty days of Lent run from Ash Wednesday up to but excluding the Mass of the Lord's Supper. On the Wednesday before the First Sunday of Lent, the faithful receive the ashes. This sign of penance, a traditionally biblical one, has been preserved among the Church's customs until the present day. **ASH WEDNESDAY** is to be observed as a day of penance in the whole Church, one of both abstinence and fasting. There are four Masses on Wednesday at which the ashes will be blessed and distributed.
