WE ARE NOT A MASS CENTER BUT A COMMUNITY

The other day I was very pleased when someone commented on the Jubilee program I put in our Parish Newsletter. She said: "Father I'm an avid reader of the newsletters of other parishes, but I have not come across one which has a program for various groups to celebrate the Jubilee Year as you have done; are you not imposing the Jubilee on your parishioners"? It was an interesting question.

Well, the reason why I produced a Jubilee year program, was based on my personal conviction that Our Lady of the Angels is not a parish center where we come to receive a service, but that we are a Community with shared characteristics. We uphold common values, or interests, we interact with each other, and we aim at creating a sense of belonging such that no matter where someone comes from, or where he/she was baptised, the moment you come through the doors of our church, you are at home.

Being a community and community building requires that we recognise and appreciate the many ways through which we express our belonging and through which we contribute to the mission of our community. We started the jubilee by thanking God for the presence of little children in our Church. Yes, we thank him for blessing families with children, it becomes the duty of parents to nurture them to love the wider family which we know as our Church. Last Sunday, we celebrated our natural families as being part of this wider family we call the parish. It becomes important that as families, we come to Sunday Mass and that we join with other families to pray for, and to thank God for the natural families to which we belong.

On the weekend of 6th April we shall thank God for his healing power among us through the ministry of doctors, nurses, care workers and their supporting staff. These professionals belong to the healing ministry of Jesus, such that to recognise their ministry, and to pray for them, becomes our duty. I wish to invite all those who work among us in this ministry to show their presence among us on that day. We really want to pray for you and to pray with you that Jesus may continue to work miracles through the works of your hands. Invite a friend if you can.

Building up our community will require recognising the many gifts that God has placed among us. There should never be competition among us, or any thought that someone's ministry is more important than another's. Therefore, pointing out different groups in our parish and praying for them as part of celebrating the Jubilee year, is one of the best things I can do as a parish priest, because without these ministries and committed people who belong to them, our church building would simply be a Mass centre, other than a community which meets at the church building.

I'm ecstatic to see you going to the parish hall after Mass for a cup of tea, coffee and for chat. I enjoy seeing children running about in the parish hall after Mass. It means that they are making new relationships which is not school based, but faith founded. Find something to be involved in or a ministry to start. Jesus has not called us to sustain a Mass Centre but to build a Community of faith with Christ at its centre.
