### **Mass for Peace at St Chad's Cathedral as part of the Eucharistic Chain 2025**

News from the Council of Bishops' Conferences of Europe (CCEE)

A Mass will be held at St Chad's Cathedral on Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> March 2025 at 12.15, celebrated by Archbishop Bernard Longley, representing the Catholic Bishops' Conference of England and Wales.

It will be part of a Lenten initiative called the Eucharistic Chain. From Ash Wednesday, and for the whole Lenten period, the Church in Europe gathers around the Eucharistic table to invoke peace. The appointment, which involves all CCEE members, sees each national Bishops' Conference committed to organising at least one Mass to pray for the victims of war and to invoke from the Lord "a just and sustainable peace especially in the Ukraine and the Holy Land".

This year's Mass for England and Wales is in the Archdiocese of Birmingham.
