McCrimmon - Cost per book £4.95 for 100+. We require 110 copies for St. Anne's and 40 for St. Joseph's.

There are 6 in the series, total cost across 3 years would be £4455 assuming prices remain the same.

An example of how to fund the cost of new books. Christ the King Parish, Coventry set up a dedication service, £5 per book with the name of the family or individual added to the inside cover.
