### Guided Tour of The Church of the Sacred Heart & St Catherine of Alexandria

The walls of the Catholic Church of the Sacred Heart and St. Catherine of Alexandria are covered with some of the finest venetian glass mosaic artwork in Europe and welcomes thousands of visitors from across the UK and other parts of the world each year to see the astonishingly beautiful scenes. The Church was built in the style of the basilica churches of Ravenna, near Venice, between 1919 and 1921. The mosaics were largely completed by 1932 and won national acclaim at the time. Throughout 2025 they are running free guided tours on one Saturday afternoon a month. Join one of the knowledgeable volunteer guides as they take you on a free guided tour of the mosaics and sculptures.
