

Café Volunteers on Saturday 3rd May, 11am. Please think about joining us. We are hoping to open the café around 9am - 12 noon Monday-Friday, and then around 6-9pm. If you can help with some or all of one session, come to the meeting and find out more. You'll only ever be working as part of a team.

Linkline Volunteers on Sat 10th May, 11am. Please think about joining us. We're hoping to simply ring up housebound or isolated people the same time same day every week, so you'd be part of a team from around 9.30am - 12.30pm on any weekday, with each person ringing 5-7 people in those 3 hours, with a chance to debrief or simply 'recover' in between. Training is given - it just needs generosity and openness and common sense.
