This week we begin our Holy Week Journey. We have our Palm Sunday Masses with the Blessing and Distribution of Palms at each one. At the 9.00am Mass, we will have Java the Donkey as part of the Procession. On Sunday afternoon we have our Passover Meal and we will start at 4.00pm. You can pay on the door when you arrive and sit with your group of family and friends. You will see that we have a sheet outlining the services for Holy Week and I would particularly draw your attention to our Confessions Service with visiting priests this Tuesday at 7.00pm. It is an important part of our Easter duties to come along to Confession. We have heard Confessions at both our Parish schools, now is an opportunity for our adults to receive the Sacrament.

Thanks to everyone who wrote to our MP concerning the Assisted Dying Bill. Please consider doing this if you have not already done so. Already the promises made in the Bill are being changed and the matter is being rushed through, even though it is one of the most important changes debated by Parliament. Please give this matter very serious consideration.

I wanted to thank all those helping with our Parish Foodbank and to thank the schools and all the volunteers for their hard work. We have had an amazing response and are able to send out 70 large food parcels each week as well as providing bulk items to some of the family centres. Thanks for your generous support and time given by all the volunteers. On a practical note, you may wish to help with our Foodbank. We may need the occasional help to drop off items, so if you are a driver and willing to help please let us know.


