DO NOT JUDGE, OR YOU TOO WILL BE JUDGED!

Having spiritual awareness directs us to examine our own thoughts, emotions and deeds. Whilst spiritual blindness hinders us from seeing our own faults. Instead, we begin to point out the mistakes of others. In such situations, we will not be able to improve and develop the spiritual strengths of goodness and holiness. In the Beatitudes, Jesus says, 'Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven' (Matt 5:3). Those who search for the truth and the holy way of life, desire to do good. If someone assumes he or she is perfect, they might become reluctant to progress spiritually. Such reluctance can lead to sloth which becomes detrimental to a spiritual and moral life. It is often easy to judge the moral, social and spiritual life of others. It is also possible that the mistakes we identify in others could also be weaknesses within us. So, the spiritual principle is, let us not judge. It is the prerogative of the Lord to judge because he sees everything that we do.

As we celebrate the 5th Sunday of Lent, the readings remind us to reflect on the infinite mercy of God and His readiness to forgive those sinners who turn to Him sincerely. In the second reading, Saint Paul thanks the Lord for his mercy and compassion and referring to his past. That through faith he had been united with the Lord Jesus. 'But one thing I do: forgetting what lies behind and straining forward to what lies ahead....' (Phil 3:13). The mercy of God is also echoed in the gospel which tells of the sinful woman. Jesus told those who had accused her, 'Let him who is without sin among you be the first to throw a stone at her' (Jn 8:7). We are told that after hearing this, all of them left one by one. They realised they had also been at fault. They became aware of their spiritual mistakes. Jesus opened their eyes and released them from their spiritual blindness. The woman was told to go but to sin no more. Her sins were forgiven, and she avoided judgement of the people, and the Lord saved her. As we move towards the Holy week, may we make a sincere confession and a perfect contribution to remove all our spiritual blind spots of pride, deceit, envy, greedy and resentment. *Fr Pontius Bandua AJ*
