York Minster, Beverley Minster, Ripon Cathedral,
Fountains Abbey, Bar Convent and the Church of the
English Martyrs in York offer us profound opportunities
to reflect on the nature of faith and hope. At each site
we will meet those men and women who died for faith:
the 50 martyrs from York, including Margaret Clitherow
and Guy Fawkes; Blessed Mary Ward at the Bar Convent,
St John Fisher born in Beverley, St Wilfrid at Ripon and
the monks at Fountains Abbey. In each site we will
reflect on those men and women who sacrificed
themselves so that we may live in faith and hope.

Led spiritually by Fr Dominic Robinson, SJ, Ecclesiastical Director of ACN UK, and supported by ACN staff and historian Suze Mathews, this pilgrimage offers a unique opportunity in this Year of Faith to pray and deepen spiritual practices at sacred sites as well as participate in bespoke historical talks, with input from the York Oratory. We invite you to join us as a pilgrim of hope, as you walk in the footsteps of the martyrs with us this July.

In order for pilgrims to control their own costs, we will eat together daily but at own cost (except for the pilgrimage dinner).

Travel to and from York from your own home is at own cost.

We meet at 5pm on Monday 21st and finish after morning Mass on Saturday 26th July.
