## "Let Your Hearts Not Be Troubled"

Challenges are not uncommon during our life's journey. The type of challenge we face can vary from one person to another depending on age or on other related factors within each society or community. But what matters most, is how well we are prepared to confront each challenge as we manoeuvre our way through life. In some situations, when we are not well prepared, the challenges can be troublesome. This can be the case with economic hardships, loss of employment, the breakdown of health, the death of a dear one or severed relationships. As Christians, we should trust in the power of the Holy Spirit which will guide us through life's journey. This can be possible if we build strong faith through prayer and personal reflection which will enable us to overcome our human emotions and feelings. It was through prayer, and the guidance of the Holy Spirit, that the difficult situations which arose within the infant Church were resolved. At the council of Jerusalem. 'Certain people came down from Judea to Antioch and were teaching the believers: Unless you are circumcised, according to the custom taught by Moses, you cannot be saved' (Acts15:1). It was a critical challenge to faith and tradition. However, through prayer and the guidance of the Holy Spirit, the elders and apostles were able to resolve the issue. Any human challenge entrusted to the light of prayer and faith can be handled well.

As we celebrate the 6th Sunday, the readings remind us to entrust our lives to the eternal Advocate as promised by our Lord Jesus. 'These things I have spoken to you while I am still with you. But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, he will teach you all things ... '(Jn14:26). The Lord reminds his followers not to be afraid but to trust in the Helper. Unless we have strong belief and commitment, when problems befall us, we can lose direction of action and hope in life. The Lord invites us to live with a peace of mind and free from worries. He said, "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. Let not your hearts be troubled, neither let them be afraid". Peace of mind in life can be possible if entrust our lives to God and do not rely on the material security of power and wealth. These are temporary realities and, therefore, they provide only a temporary security of mind. May we, therefore, learn to live by the Divine wisdom of life. *Fr. Pontius Bandua*
