'All that the Father has is mine... and the Spirit will declare it to you'

I've been struck this week by two phrases that are used in the Gospel about Christ, and then about us. Straight after Pentecost, we heard on Tuesday, 'You are the Light of the World'. That's powerful in itself, but even more so when we remember Jesus said this about himself: I am the Light of the World. If ever we need proof of the dignity that the Holy Spirit gives us, these lines are they, reminding us that we become what Jesus is: by adoption, yes, but apart from that, the gift is total. And the responsibility. Amazing.

We get a similar thing in today's Gospel: 'All that the Father has is mine' - followed by an invite to us into the life of the Trinity, that we may be one as the Father and Christ are one. Those words echo the words of the Father to the elder son in the parable of the Prodigal Son: 'my son, you are with me always, and all that I have is yours'. It is such a beautiful thing to hear. What more could any of us ask, than to hear those words of the Father. But that *is* the Word the Father has given us. And today, we not only celebrate the Trinity, and who God is, in his majesty, glory and love, but we also celebrate his invitation to be part of the Trinity - sharing in Christ's Sonship, so that we may share in their life.
