THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

After the celebration of the mysteries of our salvation during Easter tide, we now turn our reflection on to the Triune God who has revealed Himself to humanity. In a deeper and sincere devotion, we can perceive the eternal plan of God's revelation to humanity. The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is a basic doctrine of faith in Christianity, which distinguishes us from other religions or beliefs. God is One but with three distinct persons but sharing the same Divine Nature, co-equal and co-eternal. This may not be fully grasped by our finite minds because of the infinity reality of God's nature. But we need our hearts of faith to understand the mystery but not our finite minds. One of the early thinkers of this mystery, Evagrius (4th Century) said, 'God cannot be grasped by mind. If God could be grasped, God would not be God. May be this could be our modern mistaken notions or challenges to know who God is. Unless we acknowledge our limitedness in the face of His Majesty, we could easily drift to untold confusion. The Lord God is faithful and close to us and loves us as His creatures. In his image He created us male and female (Gen1:27). It is within this contest of His loving care that He saved us through His only begotten Son Jesus Christ and whose loving Spirit guides and sanctifies us.

As we celebrate the Most Holy Trinity Sunday, the readings draw our attention to the mystery of the Most Holy Trinity, the central doctrine of our faith. The second reading confirms how the love between the Father and Son has brought forth Holy Spirit to guide and lead us. Saint Paul says, 'Brothers and sisters; since we have been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. And our hope does not put us to same, because God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit' (Rm5:1, 5). The gospel confirms this unity of love among the Divine Persons. Jesus said, 'All that the Father has is mine; therefore, I said that he will take what is mine and declare it to you' (Jn12:15). May we therefore follow the example of the loving relationship among the Divine Persons to live in love, peace and unity in our families, parish community and the world community. **Fr.
